

## BULLETIN 017 YYC SHOP COMMITTEE CHAIR APPOINTMENT

March 31, 2020

Due to the financial fallout of the current and ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Air Canada has invoked Article 20.14 of the CBA, resulting in many of our fellow brothers and sisters being placed on 'Off Duty Status', including the current Chief Shop Steward AC YYC who was also recently appointed the AC YYC Shop Committee Chair.

In order to adhere to the CBA, which in accordance with Article 19.03 states that the YYC Shop Committee will consist of two (2) members who are both fully cleared (active); it is necessary that a shop steward be appointed to the Shop Committee Chair to serve the Membership.

Article 6 Section 5(e) of the LL1681 Bylaws states, "In the event of the incapacity of a Shop Committee member, the Shop Committee may designate Shop Steward as a replacement, as required. The person appointed will assume all the authority of the Committee Member affected during this period."

It has been determined that in the interim, Brother Jeff Dunn, will be 'promoted' to the role of Chief Shop Steward AC YYC and Brother Robert Nolan will be appointed to the Shop Committee. If the member in question is recalled to active duty, then the member will reassume the role of Chief Shop Steward AC YYC and the AC YYC Shop Committee Chair. If the member enters layoff status, it will become necessary for a nomination and election be held to fill the role for the remainder of the term, ending December 31, 2022.
