DL140 Convention Delegate Election (Rescheduled) and Executive Board Elections

September 9, 2020

As was previously communicated in Bulletin No. 027, the District Lodge 140 Convention Delegate election will be held on the date of the November general meeting (November 3, 2020). In addition, the election of a new YEG Trustee and possible election for Conductor Sentinel will also take place (as required).

Amid the continuing Coronavirus pandemic, providing a safe, in-person voting location is of paramount importance to ensure the health and safety of all members. All local and provincial requirements and guidelines will be followed, including: that members and tellers remain six (6) feet apart at all times, including sign-in, casting of ballots, and while observing the tally; that adequate hand sanitizer is provided; that people wear masks while voting; and that there are a sufficient number of pens, so that people do not share the same pen when casting a ballot, or that pens are properly cleaned in between uses.

If despite these measures taken, members have concerns about in-person voting due to Coronavirus (e.g., they or members of their family are in an at-risk group, or they are subject to a quarantine) members have the right to request an absentee ballot, by marking the box indicating that they are unable to vote due to illness or injury. Members requesting to vote in the election by absentee ballot must make their request by delivering the attached form no later than October 6, 2020.

We also want to reiterate that all members currently on laid off status are eligible to vote, so we encourage everyone to cast a ballot.

Polling stations will be located at the RCL Chapelhow Branch 284 (606 38 Ave. N.E. Calgary, AB) and the Nisku Inn (1101 4th St. Nisku, AB) in Edmonton. Polling hours will be communicated in the near future.
