Grand Lodge Election Office of General Secretary-Treasurer (GST) (Amended)

March 10, 2021

Following the endorsement vote held previously on Saturday, February 13, 2021, two (2) candidates received the endorsement of twenty-five (25) or more local lodges for the office of General Secretary-Treasurer (GST). Subsequently, there is a requirement for an election meeting to be held on Saturday, April 24, 2021 at the same location that previously hosted the nomination meeting:

The polling hours will also remain the same from 0600 to 0800 and from 1800 to 2000. The meetings will remain open until every member present before the closing time has had the opportunity to vote. To assist in verifying the eligibility of those who wish to participate in this process, we request that members bring the original letter issued to them by the Grand Lodge to the election meeting. Only members in good standing of the local lodge may participate in the election process. Eligible members can access an absentee ballot request form by visiting the website **go.iam.org.** From the main banner, click on *Grand Lodge Elections*, followed by *Read More*. Scroll down the page and select the link for a Canadian Absentee Ballot Request Form.

Absentee ballot request forms should be mailed out as soon as possible, but no later than ten (10) days prior to the voting date (April 24, 2021), set forth in the **Notice of Nominations and Elections** to:

The Grand Lodge will confirm a member's eligibility to vote by absentee ballot and mail out a ballot and instructions within two (2) days after receipt of the request. Members found not eligible to vote by absentee ballot will be sent notification within two (2) days after receipt of the request.

Absentee ballots for the April election must be received by the Canadian office of the Grand Lodge by April 22, 2021. Absentee ballots received after the dates set forth will not be counted.

Protests regarding the April 24, 2021 election should be filed as soon as possible, but no later than ten (10) days after the completion of the ballot tally, to be held in May 2021.
