Polling stations will be located in YYC at the RCL Chapelhow Branch 284 (606 38 Ave. NE, Calgary, AB) and in YEG at the Nisku Inn (1101 4th St. Nisku, AB). Polling hours will be announced in the near future.

As society continues to cope with the fourth wave of the pandemic, providing a safe environment to conduct in-person voting is of upmost importance, ensuring the health and safety of all members.
