Polling stations will open at 0800 and close at 2000. The polling station for YEG will be located at the Nisku Inn (1101 4th St. Nisku, AB). The location of the YYC polling station is TBD.

As society continues to withstand the Omicron-driven fifth wave of the pandemic, providing a safe environment to conduct in-person voting is of upmost importance to ensure the health and safety of all members. All local and provincial public health restrictions will be observed, including people wearing masks and remaining six (6) feet apart at all times, including during sign-in, the casting of ballots, and while observing the tally. Hand sanitizer will be available, and all pens used to cast a ballot will be wiped down with a disinfectant wipe after each use.

If members have concerns about in-person voting, despite the strict adherence to all relevant public health restrictions, they have the right to request an absentee ballot, by marking the box indicating they are unable to vote due to illness or injury.
