The IAM Grand Lodge has issued a call for the Women's Leadership Program to be held February 19-24, 2023 at the William W. Winpisinger Education and Technology Center (W3) in Hollywood, MD, USA.

This course from the Women's and Human Rights Department is designed to motivate union sisters to become active members within their local lodge. The program is designed to build leadership skills and develop skills in the areas of organizing, parliamentary procedure, political and legislative involvement, strategic planning, and network building,

The W3 is committed to protecting the health and safety of all participants who attend and staff who work at the facility. Participants attending in-person programs at W3 must be fully vaccinated at least two (2) weeks before the program starts and also be able to provide proof of vaccination prior to attendance. Attendees are also expected to follow the facilities' most up to date COVID protocols.
