## *CLC – Ottawa Lobby on the Hill*

### *(February 6-8, 2023)*

The IAMAW will be participating in the Canadian Labour Congress (CLC) Lobby Day on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The following three (3) issues will be the focus of the lobbying efforts:

- Investments in the Care Industry
- **Just Transition and Sustainable Jobs**
- **Anti-Scab Legislation**

Two (2) of the three (3) issues are pertinent to the airline sector and has the potential to have a direct impact on our workplace and communities. All efforts will be made to ensure at least one (1) person in each lobby delegation is a constituent of the Member of Parliament (MP) being lobbied.

A mandatory planning and training session will be held on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 1800 at the Shaw Centre, with registration opening at 1715, so participant(s) must be available from February 6-8, 2023, allowing for travel. Participants will be expected to write a report detailing what was learned, the effectiveness of lobbying politicians, and whether or not this was a worthwhile project.

The deadline to register is no later than January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Selected applicant(s) will be provided with a link to the online registration form and will be required to provide their cellphone number and an email address where they can be reached leading up to and on the day of the lobby, so any schedule or logistics changes can be communicated in a timely manner as needed during the lobby day.

If needed, the selected member(s) will be afforded with three (3) days of time clearance from Air Canada. For convenience, a link will be provided to reserve airfare and accommodations, as a flight discount has been secured, as well as a block of rooms reserved.
